If your child attends Nessy sessions before school, they are recommending on Monday 15th January.





























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Portobello Parent/Carer Fundraising Committee

Key Stage One Bags Reminder

The children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 should only bring to school a book bag and PE bag to school. We do not have room to store 'personal school bags' daily on their pegs and children are not required to bring to school anything daily other than a water bottle. Please help make the cloakrooms safe and accessible by not sending your child to school with a bag. If you feel your child requires a bag for personal items, please speak to a member of the Key Stage One team who will be able to accommodate this in an alternative place. Thank you for your cooperation.

Payments

Please ensure all trips/school lunches etc are paid for online where possible via School gateway. Please ensure breakfast club is booked and paid for online ahead of the session required too.

School dinner money: please aim to clear your account on a weekly or at most, monthly basis. If your account becomes in arrears for a month, you will be asked to provide your child with a packed lunch until the account is in credit.

If any of your child's emergency contact list needs updating, please advise. If you have changed address or do so in the future, you must keep us informed.

Parking in and around school



Once again, we have received complaints from our school neighbours. Can we please ask you to park with consideration when dropping off or collecting your children. Please do not block driveways, please do not pull up and park on grassy verges. The community police have informed residents to make note of car registrations and complain officially if this continues. Please park sensibly! If you need to bring a vehicle, can you park a short distance away from school, and walk a short distance, this is safer for our children too and won't congest the immediate street which is preferable.
