## Dates for your diary - Meet the teacher

- Year 1 Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September
- Year 2 Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September
- Year 3 Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September
- Year 4 Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September
- Year 5 Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September
- Year 6 Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September

You are invited to meet your child's class teacher for a short, informal meeting on the above dates at 4.30p.m. You will get to know more about what is happening at school and ways you can help your child too.

If you can't make it to any of the sessions or you have a clash of meetings with more than one year group to attend, don't worry! Following the events, we will have copies of the presentations.

## Start and end of the day procedures

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 (new times)

- Children should be brought on to the infant yard between <u>8.40am 8.50am</u> where a senior member of staff will be waiting to admit them to the building. Once your child has been admitted they will go straight to their classroom to start a morning task. Doors will close at 8.50am promptly and registers taken.
- All classes will be dismissed on to the infant yard at 3.20pm. Reception will leave from their outdoor area, Year 1 from the door they enter on a morning and Year 2 from the library external door.

<u> Year 3 - Year 6</u>

- Children should be brought to the main gates between <u>8.40am 8.55am</u> where a senior member of staff will be waiting to admit them to the building. Once your child has been admitted they will go straight to their classroom to start a morning task. Gates will close at 8.55am promptly and registers taken.
- Year 3 and Year 4 will be dismissed on to the Key Stage 2 yard by the class teacher or teaching assistant at 3.25pm prompt
- Year 5 and Year 6 will be dismissed on to the Key Stage 2 yard by the class teacher or teaching assistant at 3.30pm prompt

Any child arriving after 8.55am must be brought to the main office by a parent/carer where a reason will be recorded which may be discussed with the Headteacher and Governing Body should it cause a concern to your child's learning.
