Support for families

If you are a member of the Armed Services, you will probably already know all about the government's funding scheme - Service Children Pupil Premium. The additional funding aims to help schools provide a support system for service children, who often have to move schools regularly or deal with separation from a parent serving overseas. For schools to secure the right funding to support pupils, we must have correct information recorded for your child. Therefore, can you please let the us know if either parent/carer is a current serving member of the Armed Services.

In addition, the DFE make additional funds available for students who have been adopted from care. You are under no obligation for provide us with this information, however, if you wish to discuss this any further, please contact us to make an appointment to meet with myself or Miss West, Deputy Headteacher.

Please remember if your financial circumstances change even for a short while you may be entitled to benefits related free school meals which will stay with your child, under the current regulations, for the rest of their school days and schools can also provide support with the likes of breakfast clubs, after school clubs and trips too. Eschools and Communication from September 23

Re School gateway/ParentPay APP notifications re meals/trips/clubs

If you are now using the APP you may notice a meal purchase history notification being sent via School Gateway App - this will occur if your child receives benefit related free school meals, universal free school meals (Reception, Y1 and Y2) as well as a home packed lunch. These are merely noted as transactions.

You may see a debit of \pounds 2.90 displayed in the top left-hand corner of the notification, this is due to the meal data which comes through from SIMS. SIMS is our school internal system which we use daily to record attendance and dinner choices.

However, you should also notice the balance is ± 0.00 therefore confirming you are not being charged for these transactions, this is purely a purchase history notification.

If your child is in Y3 to Y6 and they are taking paid school meals you will see a balance which is owed, you will also receive a notification if the balance on the account falls to £2.90 (one school meal).

For dinner money owed please refer to our Dinner Money Policy, which is located on the school website, we expect dinner money to be paid promptly and in advance of dinners being taken. Should you require a printed copy of the policy please contact the school office.
